Nairobi Excursions

DTKT 001 Nairobi City Tour (3hours)

The tour covers the modern city centre, the colourful market, the Railway Museum and the renowned National Museum where there are spellbinding displays of early man, tribal regalia and the flora and fauna of Kenya. A visit to the adjacent snake park is also included. The tour turns to the city centre



DTKT 002 Nairobi National Park The tour starts at 2.00pm.

This unique wildlife sanctuary is just a few kilometres from Nairobi's bustling city centre, but despite its proximity, different species of mammals can be found there, including four of the Big Five. The tour also includes a visit to the animal orphanage at the park gate. The tour returns to the city centre by sundown. Private tours can be organised in the morning

DTKT 003 Karen Blixen & Giraffe Centre (3 hours)

Depart in the morning and afternoon. Drive towards Ngong Hills and pass Ngong Village to the Karen Blixen Museum, for many years her home. Later proceed to the Giraffe Centre to see and feed the famous Rothschild Giraffe and her family.

DTKT 007 Lake Nakuru National Park (1 day)

Lake Nakuru lies in the volcano-strewn Rift Valley, one of the shares of 8 lakes, which stretch the length of Kenya from Tanzania to Ethiopia. The 160 kilometres drive from Nairobi passes through highlands farms of the Kikuyu people before descending an escarpment into the dramatic landscape of the Rift Valley. Lunch is taken in Nairobi; a stop is made at Lake Nakuru where tea is served among the fever trees and where bird watchers will be delighted with the fantastic array of bird life.



DTKT 008 Amboseli Express (1 day)

Amboseli National Park lies within the shadow of the mighty Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest mountain. Only nature in all the majesty could create such a backdrop of the wildlife pageant found at Amboseli. Game is seen on much of the route to the park, which crosses ochre plains where Masai tend their cattle in an age-old tradition. Lunch is taken at the lodge in the park and is followed by another game drive where lion, elephant and the splendid cheetah are likely to be seen. Return to Nairobi in good time for dinner.



DTKT 071 South Africa Highlights (7 nights)

Direction & Schedule: Johannesburg to Cape Town / 8:30 every Thursday

Day 1 Thursday

Depart after breakfast for a full day of sightseeing as we travel along the Drakensberg escarpment. The scenic panorama route takes us to the Blyde River Canyon, Three Rondawels, God's Window, Bourke's Luck Potholes and the nostalgic village of Pilgrim's Rest, where gold was discovered in the 1870's, before we continue on our decent down the mountain into the Lowveld, a sub-tropical paradise of fruit. Indulge in the nature's beauty at the Lone Creek waterfall before we continue to our hotel near Hazyview. Dinner, Overnight and Breakfast at the Winkler Hotel - White River

Day 2 Friday

Early morning at sunrise we make our way into the world famous Kruger Park for a full day game drive in search of the wildlife wonders Africa offers her visitors in this unspoiled land where big game still roam freely. We might even spot the Big Five (Lion, Elephant, Rhino, Buffalo and Leopard). At sunset we arrive at our rest camp for overnight. (Option for night drive) Dinner, Overnight and Breakfast at Rest Camp - Kruger Park



Day 3 Saturday

Our last opportunity to spot more game before we exit the Kruger Park. We travel via White River and Nelspruit and return to the plains of the highveld to arrive in Johannesburg late afternoon. Overnight and Breakfast and Rosebank Hotel - Johannesburg

Day 4 Sunday

Morning at leisure to explore the city (optional excursions available). Afternoon transfer to the airport for flight to Port Elizabeth (not included). Transfer to your hotel. Overnight and Breakfast at 39 on Church Guest House - Port Elizabeth

Day 5 Monday

After a short orientation tour of this city influenced by the 1820 British settlers, we continue along this spectacular coast known as the garden route along Storms River, through the Tsitsikamma Forests over the old and scenic Grootrivier Pass and Bloukrans Pass from days gone by and via Plettenberg Bay, to Knysna. Dinner, Overnight and Breakfast at Knysna River Club - Knysna

Day 6 Tuesday


Depart after breakfast to board the Outeniqua Choo - Tjoe in George. This original steam train takes you along the spectacular coastline via the Kaaimans River Bridge and Wilderness to Knysna. Afternoon we embark on a cruise on the Knysna Lagoon. Remainder of the day at leisure. Dinner, Overnight and Breakfast at Knysna River Club - Knysna

Day 7 Wednesday

After breakfast we travel over the Outeniqua Pass to Oudtshoorn, known as the feather capital of the world. We visit the famous Cango Caves as well as an Ostrich Show Farm and the Cango Wildlife Ranch and Cheetah Breeding Centre for guided tours. Dinner, Overnight and Breakfast at La Plume Guest House - Oudtshoorn

Day 8 Thursday

Depart after breakfast and continue to Mosselbay where we visit the Maritime Museum and old Post Office Tree. From here we continue to Swellendam and on to Cape Town to arrive late afternoon where the tour ends.

DTKT 039 Southern Cape Circle

Route (3 nights)

Time: Morning & afternoon

Day 1 Cape Town - Riebeek West(D)

Travel to Blouberg beachfront for a post-card view of Table Mountain across the Bay. Continue up the West Coast then travel inland, through rolling savannah to Riebeek Kasteel and Riebeek West. This little bit of tranquility is set up against the Kasteelberg Mountain and boasts one of South Africa's premier wine estates, "Allesveloren".

Overnight: Riebeek Valley Hotel, Table mount view

Day 2 Riebeek West- Stellenbosch(BD)

Travel via historic Tulbach with its lovely examples of Cape Dutch architecture through to Ceres, a fruit producing region. Then travel through the winelands of the Cape to historic Stellenbosch.

Overnight: d'Ouwe Werf.

Day 3 Stellenbosch - Haemaus(BD)

After selected wine tasting, visit Franschoek, know for its strong French-Huge-not history. Explore on your own indulge in some chocolate tasting before travelling to Haemanus, famous for its shore based whale watching (June to September). Your hotel is situated on the cliff above the ocean and walk across the road allows for some lovely views of the Atlantic.

Ovenight:Auberger Burgundy

Day 4 Oudtshoorn - Cape Town(B)

Travel past the Huis River and Traouw Mountain Passes to the charming town of the Swellendam, and then into the apple orchards in and around Grabouw. Arrive in Cape Town late this afternoon. (Drop offs at City Hotels or Cpae Town International Airport). Reverse departures begin in Cape Town and end in Port Elizabeth, with drop offs at city hotels or Port Elizabeth Airport.



Day 5 Stellenbosch - Haemaus(BD)

After a lazy breakfast, leave Hermanus and travel along the coast through holiday towns and villages such as Bett's Bay, Pringle Bay and then via Gordon's Bay and the N2 Freeway all the way to Cape Town, arriving this afternoon.

DTKT 070 Highlights of the Garden (2nights)

Time: Departs on Request

Day 1 Port Elizabeth - Knysna(D)

Travel via the forests of the Tsitsikamma to the Garden Route. Make a short trip in Plettenberg Bay and then continue on to Knysna, arriving early this afternoon.

Overnight: Knysna Quays

Day 2 Grootbos(BD)

Choose from a variety of included activities today such as: 4x4 drives, fynbos and floral trails coastal walks and optional boat tours to view seals, penguins and the Southern Right Whale (July to October). Overnight: Grootbos Private Nature Reserve. Boat based whale watching, Grootbos Nature Reserve.

Day 3 Knysna - Oudtshoorn(BD)

Today's scenic drive takes you first to Mossel Bay and then over the Robinson Pass to Oudtshoorn where you tour an ostrich show farm & the Cango Caves. Time permitting, there is an optional tour of the Crocodile & Cheetah Park.

Overnite: Riempie Estate Hotel Ostrich farm oudtshoorn

Day 4 Grootbos - Cape - Town(B)

Enjoy a final morning before your guide arrives at 1100 to take you back to Cape Town, (arriving around 1300). Drop off at the Airport or a City Hotel

DTKT 009 Amboseli by road (2 nights)

Departs Daily from Nairobi at 1400 hrs.

Day 1 Nairobi - Amboseli

Drive south to Amboseli in the afternoon, arriving early in the evening. Overnight stay at the Ol Tukai Lodge.

Day 2 Amboseli

Rise early this morning to catch view of Mt. Kilimanjaro. Enjoy morning, mid morning and afternoon game drives. Overnight stay at the Ol. Tukai Lodge.

Day 3 Amboseli - Nairobi

After breakfast return to Nairobi by road.

DTKT010 Tree Tops Hotel (1 night) Departs

Departs daily from Nairobi at 0900 hrs.

Day 1 Nairobi - Aberdares

Drive to the base hotel for lunch before continuing to your tree lodge for the night. Enjoy nocturnal game viewing as the animals come to the floodlight water hole to drink water and scratch for salt. Overnight stay the Treetops / The ark.

Day 2 Aberdares - Nairobi

After Breakfast, return to Nairobi.

DTKT 012 Masai Mara by road (2 nights)

Departs daily from Nairobi at 0800 hrs.

Day 1 Nairobi - Masai Mara

Drive to the Masai Mara, arriving around midday. After lunch, enjoy a game drive in the park. Overnight stay at the Mara Simba Lodge/luxury camp.

Day 2 Masai Mara

Enjoy both morning and afternoon game drives. Overnight stay at the Mara Simba Lodge/luxury camp.

Day 3 Masai Mara - Nairobi

After breakfast return to Nairobi by road.

DTKT 022 Lake Nakuru & Masai Mara (3 nights)

Departs daily from Nairobi at 0900 hrs.

Day 1 Lake Nakuru National Park

Depart and drive to Lake Nakuru National Park. Lunch at the Lodge & afternoon game viewing drive. Dinner and overnight stay at the lodge.

Day 2 Masai Mara Game Reserve

Depart after breakfast and drive to the Masai Mara game Reserve arriving in time for lunch. Afternoon game viewing drive. Dinner and overnight stay at a lodge/luxury camp.

Day 3 Masai Mara Game Reserve

Morning and late afternoon game viewing drives in this reserve with all meals and overnight stay at a lodge/ luxury camp.

Day 4 Departure

Breakfast at the lodge and check out. Then depart and drive back to Nairobi arriving in time to arrange for own lunch. Thereafter transfer to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your onward flight. Note: Nairobi accommodation not included in the above program but can be provided on request.

DTKT 036 Aberdare Experience (2 nights)

Day 1 Nairobi - Aberdares

Drive to the base hotel for lunch before continuing to your tree lodge for the night. Enjoy nocturnal game viewing as the animals come to the floodlit water hole to drink water and scratch for salt. Overnight stay the Treetops / The ark.

Day 2 Aberdares

After Breakfast at the tree hotel to at the base hotel. The day is at leisure to enjoy some of the optional activities available at the base hotel. Over night stay at the OutSpan Lodge.

Day 3 Aberdares - Nairobi

After Breakfast, return to Nairobi



Nairobi Long Safaris

DTKT034 Amboseli / Lake Nakuru / Masai Mara (5 nights)

Day 1

0800 hours pick up from the hotel and drive to Amboseli National park, arriving in time for lunch at the lodge. After lunch time to relax followed by afternoon game drive. Amboseli national Park is a seasonal swamp, during wet season the waters spill over a large area, attracting many different animals and a great variety of birds. During the dry season the swamp dries up and the landscape is alive with swirling dust. The park is always dominated by the bulk of Mt. Kilimanjaro, the highest mountain in Africa. The snow can be seen early in the morning or late afternoon. Animals to be seen are elephant, buffalo, wildebeest, zebra, ostrich, giraffe, lion. All meals and overnight stay at Ol Tukai Lodge.

Day 2

Full day spent in Amboseli with morning and afternoon game drives. All meals and overnight stay at Ol Tukai Lodge.

Day 3

After breakfast drive via Nairobi and proceed to Lake Elementaita for lunch, then proceed to Lake Nakuru National Park for afternoon game drive. All meals and overnight stay at Lake Nakuru Lodge.

Day 4

After breakfast drive to Masai Mara Gamer Reserve arriving in time for lunch at the lodge. After lunch time to relax followed by afternoon game drive in the park. All meals and overnight stay at the Mara Sopa Lodge.

Day 5

Full day spend in Masai Mara with morning and afternoon game drives. All meals and overnight stay at the Mara Sopa Lodge.



Day 6

After breakfast drive back to Nairobi arriving in time for lunch (lunch on own arrangement). Later transfer to the airport for departure flight home.

DTKT 035 The Ark / Lake Nakuru / Masai Mara (4 nights)

Day 1

0800 hours pick up from the hotel and drive out of Nairobi, past business complexes and into the open country where you will see coffee and tea growing. Drive onto Nyeri arriving in time for lunch at Outspan Hotel. This Beautiful hotel was the last home of Lord Baden Powell, founder of the Boy Scout Movement. After Lunch join the transport which departs for Treetops for afternoon game viewing from the hotel lounge. Treetops overlooks floodlit waterholes visited regularly by buffalo, elephant, eland and bush pig. Dinner and overnight at Treetops/The Ark.

Day 2

After an early morning tea drive to Outspan Hotel for breakfast. Drive to Lake Nakuru National Park arriving in time for lunch at the lodge. After lunch, time to relax followed by afternoon game drive in the scenic park, world famous for its millions of flamingos and other bird species. Animals to be seen are buffalo, leopard, lion, water buck, giraffe and rhino. All meals and overnight stay at Lake Nakuru Lodge/Mbweha Tented Camp.

Day 3

After an early breakfast drive along the floor of the Rift Valley and turn left to climb up Western wall of the escarpment to arrive in Masai Mara Game Reserve in time for lunch at the lodge. After lunch time to relax followed by afternoon game drive in the park. Masai Mara is home to the highest concentration of animals and it is in this area that the annual migration of animals takes place between July and October. Animals to be seen include elephant, buffalo, cheetah, lion, leopard, topi, impala, gazelles and giraffe. All meals and overnight stay at the Mara Sopa Lodge.

Day 4

Full day spent in Masai Mara with morning and afternoon game drives. All meals and overnight stay at the Mara Sopa Lodge.

Day 5

After breakfast drive back to Nairobi to arrive in time for lunch (lunch on this day is on own arrangement). Later transfer to the airport for departure flight home.

Uganda safaris

DTKT 066 Search of Gorilla (5 nights) Departs daily on request

Day 1 Arrive ENTEBBE KAMPALA

Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel Kampala. The remainder of the day is leisure. Overnight: Sheraton Hotel Kampala

Day 2 Kampala - Lake Buyonyi

Taking a picnic lunch you drive through scenic countryside to lake Buyonyi. The lake is dotted with small islands and one of the main islands was a Dutch leper colony until 1969. Overnight: Far Out Islands Camp

Day 3 Lake Buyonyi - Bwindi National Park (BLD)

You have to take a short walk or a chance to fish or canoe before the lake leaving to drive into the mountains to Bwindi Forest. Bwindi means "a place of darkness", aptly derived from the thick vegetation of the forest. The afternoon is at leisure at your camp. Overnight: Buhoma Luxury Tented Camp

Day 4 Bwindi National Park (BLD)

Excitement builds for your day of trekking in search of elusive and endangered mountain gorilla. Nothing can eclipse a moment with these magnificent creatures. Depending on when you find your "group" gorillas, you will enjoy a picnic lunch before trek back to camp. Overnight: Buhoma Luxury Tented Camp

Day 5 Bwindi - Entebbe (BLD)

Drive back to Entebbe with lunch en route. Windsor Lake Victoria Hotel

Day 6 Entebbe - Depart (B)

Transfer to the airport for your departure flight.

DTKT 067 Queen Elizabeth National Park & Murchison Falls Departs daily on request

Day 1 Arrive ENTEBBE KAMPALA

Upon arrival at Entebbe, you will be met and transferred to Kampala for the night. Overnight: Sheraton Hotel Kampala

Day 2 Kampala Queen Elizabeth National park (BLD)

Originally named after a visit by Queen Elizabeth II in 1954. Birdwatchers will delight in the over 540 recorded species found in the park, and on the morning visit to the bird hide on Mweya Peninsula you may spot cormorants, goliath herons, sacred ibis and fish eagles.

This afternoon's boat cruise on Kizinga channel may give you a close up view of the abundant hippos found in the channel.

Overnight: Mweya safari lodge

Day 3 Kampala Queen Elizabeth National park - Murchinson Falls (BLD)

A full day drive in the shadow of the Mountains of the moon takes you to Murchinson Falls National Park. Overnight: Sarova Paraa lodge

Day 4 Murchinson Falls (BLD)

Covering almost 4,000sq. kms, Murchison is the largest and perhaps most beautiful park in Uganda. The waters of the Nile River now form 2 cascading falls of about 50 metres. This morning game drive might reveal elephant, buffalo and possibly lion. This afternoon, enjoy Nile river cruise. Watch hippos and crocodiles. Overnight: Sarova Paraa lodge

Day 5 Murchinson Falls (BLD)

Game viewing from the water gives you a different perspective today. As you cruise from Paraa to the base of the falls, you will likely see elephants, buffalos, and waterbuck along the banks. But the highlight is the search for the Shoebill. This large bird prey is best known for its bizarre appearance capped with a Cheshire cat like grin. The afternoon at leisure.


Overnight: Sarova Paraa lodge

Day 6 Murchinson Falls - Entebbe(BLD)

As you leave today, drive to the top of Murchison Falls to experience the full power of the falls. Then the return to Entebbe where the remainder of the day is at leisure. Overnight: Windsor lake victoria hotel

Day 7 Entebbe - Depart(B)

Transfer to the airport for your departure flight today.

DTKT 061 Stone Town Gateway (2 nights)

DTKT 064 Mangapwani Slave Caves

Departs daily from Stone Town Hotels and Beach Hotels.

Along a beautiful stretch of white sandy beach lies a hidden cove said to be used for hiding slaves after their export was forbidden in 1873. Enjoy lunch and time to swim and relax on the beach.



Hiking time: 7 hours

Distance: About 15km

Habitat: Semi desert

You turn eastwards and continue ascending through the dry landscape before dropping again to reach Barranco Hut. Overnight stay at the camp.

Day 5 Barranco - Barafu Camp

Hiking time: 7 hours

Distance: About 13 hours

Habitat: Alpine Desert

The path climbs steep out of the Barranco valley and crosses the Karanga valley, then turns north to reach Barafu Hut. Overnight stay at the camp.

Day 6: Summit Attempt!!

Barafu Camp - Uhuru Peak - Mweka

Hiking time: 8 hours to reach Uhuru Peak, 7/8 hours to descend to Mweka

Distance: About 7 km ascent - 23 km descent

Habitat: Stone scree and ice-capped summit

A long day with an early start to reach the crater, reach the Stella point in time for sunrise, then to Uhuru peak, the highest point in Africa. Afterwards, descend to Gilman's point and down to Horombo Hut. Overnight stay at the camp.

Day 7

Descend down passing Mandara Hut to the gate where you are transferred back to your hotel in Moshi for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 8

After breakfast board shuttle bus from your hotel and proceed to Nairobi arriving late in the afternoon (6:30pm)



Mt. Kilimanjaro climb

DTKT 60

Any physically fit person can climb it. No climbing experience necessary. The mountain climb can be in any month except during long rains in April and May. The best months are January to March and August to October usually with cloudless days. There are two peaks: Mawenzi 5149m and Kibo 5895m.

Route 1 Marangu Route (7 days)

Day 1 Nairobi - Moshi

Board shuttle from Nairobi at 0800hrs and proceed to Arusha arriving at 1300hrs. Depart for Moshi at 1400hrs arriving at 1530hrs. Dinner and overnight at a hotel in Moshi or (pick up from Kilimanjaro airport and transfer to hotel in Moshi)

Day 2 Marungu Gate - Mandara Hut

Hiking time: 5 hours

Distance: 12km

Habitat: Montane forest Moorland

After breakfast, start the climb through fascinating rain forests till you reach the first hut Mandara. Meals and overnight stay at the hut (9,000ft)

Day 3 Mandara Hut - Horombo Hut

Hiking time: 6 hours

Distance: about 15km

Habitat: Moorland.

After breakfast, follow the ascending path through the alpine - meadow. The altitude begins to change and slowdown your pace while enjoying the flora and the view of Mawenzi and Kibo peaks. Arrive at the Horombo Hut 12km from Mandara. Meals and overnight stay at the hut (12,520 ft)

Day 4 Horombo Hut - Kibo Hut

Hiking time: 6 hours

Distance: About 15km

Habitat: Alpine desert

After breakfast, resume climb, the landscape becomes rugged and rocky. Lobelias begin to appear. Climb to Kibo Hut. Meals and overnight stay at the Hut. (15,520ft)

Day 5 Summit Attempt!!

Kibo Hut - Kibo Peak - Horombo Hut

Hiking time: 8 hours to Uhuru, 6 hours to descend to Horombo Hut

Habitat: Stone scree and ice-capped summit

The beginning of the last ascent is made in the wee hours of the morning while the scree is still frozen. Climb the very steep part of the route to Gilman's Point (most difficult and tiring part). Uhuru Peak is reached within an hour's walk along the crater rim (19,344ft). Start the descent to Horombo Hut for overnight stay.

Day 6 Horombo hut - Marangu Gate

Hiking time: 6 hours

Distance: about 27 km

Return to a hotel in Moshi. After lunch, have a good rest, meals and overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 7

After breakfast, depart for your next destination, which is optional, either:

- The National Park (this can be arranged)
- Kilimanjaro airport
- Arusha Town
- Nairobi via border town Namanga arriving at 6:30 p.m.



